ORAL ORDER

5 02-12-2024 Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A, 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. By order dated 22.07.2024, this matter was referred to the Patna High Court Mediation and Conciliation Centre to resolve the dispute between the parties.

4. The learned Mediator vide its report dated 20.09.2024 has, inter alia, reported that a settlement has been arrived at between the parties as per the terms and conditions as mentioned in the report.

5. As the dispute has already been resolved between the parties, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail,



in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Complaint Case No. 8605(C) of 2022, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.

6. The petitioner is directed to comply the learned Mediator’s report dated 20.09.2024, if the petitioner will not comply learned Mediator’s report dated 20.09.2024, then the opposite party no. 2 would be at liberty to file an application for cancellation of bail.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner has produced two Demand Drafts of Rs.1,50,000/- (One Lakh Fifty Thousand) **each** in Court. Let a copy of the same be kept on record and the same be handed over to learned counsel for the opposite party no. 2.
