“1. That this application is for issuance of the writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents and private respondents to stop the unauthorised construction work and to demolish the illegal construction upon Khata No. 108 Khesra No. 105, 206 and 209 Mohalla Bharat Raut Katara, Ward No. 33, P.S.
