3 05-07-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Birpur P.S. Case No. 69 of 2023, dated 13.05.2023 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 342, 363 and 365 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned A.P.P. for the State, at the outset, submits that the offences for which the instant FIR has been instituted carry punishment of seven years and less.

4. The said submission of the learned A.P.P. is not disputed by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners.

No. 3536 of 2024 and the concerned Superintendent of Police shall ensure that the Investigating Officer of the case strictly adheres to the direction contained in the said order dated 13.02.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 3536 of 2024.
