In such circumstances, we direct the husband to give an intimation before the concerned Police Station that he is going out of Patna and also inform the Police Station, as soon as he comes back to his family residence.

2. As of now, the Police will continue the vigil as directed in the orders and we are of the opinion that the matter



can be closed. If at all, there is any difficulty faced by the couple, they can move the Habeas Corpus petition for consideration.

3. The writ petition stands disposed off in terms of the interim order passed; leaving liberty as above.
