- 3 12-01-2024 The learned counsel for the contemnors has submitted that there is no disobedience of the order of this Court dated 08.08.2022, passed in CWJC No. 1804 of 2019, by the opposite parties inasmuch as the order passed by the Circle Officer, Thakraha, District-West Champaran dated 08.06.2018 has been set aside by a coordinate Bench of this Court, vide order dated 09.02.2023, passed in CWJC No. 16545 of 2022 and liberty has been granted to the parties to avail appropriate



remedies, in accordance with law.
