2 26-04-2024 We see that broad allegations are made of misconduct and corruption in jails without even specifying one instance and without impleading any of the parties in their personal capacity. The petitioner names a number of individuals in the writ petition who are said to be agents of the jail authorities; without any of them in the party array. The petition is one filed with abject



levity and we discern from the scanty and sketchy allegations made, a very lackadaisical attitude. We were of the opinion that the petition is misconceived and the matter has to be dismissed with exemplary costs.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, sought for withdrawal of the writ petition, in which circumstance, we permit withdrawal of the writ petition.

3. The writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with a severe warning to the petitioner.
