2 29-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

"1. For issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other appropriate writ / order / direction to the respondents to ensure safety and security of petitioner (senior citizen) and to get petitioner's self acquired house bearing property no. 711023940, New Holding No. 016, old



Holding No. 015, in ward no. 52, in District- Gaya, be vacated from forceful occupation of petitioner's son namely Sudhanshu Shekher who is constant threat and detrimental to the medical practice and livelihood of the petitioner and at the same time has made petitioner's life extremely miserable and difficult to live in his own house peacefully. "

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the District Magistrate, Gaya as also the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gaya for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
