2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Maheshkhunt P.S. Case No. 21 of 2021, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 356 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The prosecution case as emerges from the FIR is that some unknown miscreants came on motorcycle and snatched the bag of the informant containing a cash of Rs. 1,74,000/-, and some valuable articles near Prakash Keshari Shop, in Maheshkhunt.

4. Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this



case. He further submits the the FIR has been lodged against unknown persons and the name of the Petitioner has transpired only in the confessional statement of the co-accused. He further submits that no recovery has been made from the possession of the Petitioner. He also submits that no TIP has been conducted in this case as yet.

5. He further submits that the petitioner has been languishing in jail since 05.08.2023

6. It has also been stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition that the petitioner has earlier been made accused in six other cases out of which he is on bail in four cases.

7. It is also stated in paragraph no. 2 of the bail petition that the petitioner has not moved this Court earlier either for anticipatory bail or regular one.

8. However, Ld. APP for the State vehemently opposes the prayer of the petitioner for bail.

9. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, **this application is allowed**, directing the petitioner, above-named, to be enlarged on bail on his



furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 10,000 /- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Ld. Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khagaria in connection with Maheskhunt P.S. Case No. 21 of 2021 on the following conditions:

(i) The petitioner will make himself available for interrogation by a police officer/court as and when required.

(ii) The petitioner will undertake that investigation/trial will not get hampered on account of his absence or non-cooperation. He must be available to the police or the court whenever his presence is required.

(iii) The petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer.

(iv) In case, it is brought to the notice of the court below that the petitioner has criminal antecedents other than the disclosed one, Ld. court below shall cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner after hearing him and getting satisfied that



the petitioner has concealed his criminal antecedents despite his knowledge of the same.

(v) In case, it is brought to the notice of the court below that statement regarding previous bail petition is wrong, Ld. court below shall cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
