ORAL ORDER

2 08-04-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
K.Nagar (Champanagar) P.S. Case No. 27 of 2024 instituted for
the offence under Sections 354, 354(A), 354(B), 354(c), 506 &
509 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Prosecution case in short is that petitioner has
forcibly tired to take away the daughter of the informant when
she was coming alone after giving tuition.

4. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner
that the petitioner is in custody since 16-01-2024. Petitioner is a
man of clean antecedent.

5. It has been further submitted by the petitioner's



counsel that petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. There is delay of two days in lodging of the FIR. It is submitted that prior to lodging of the instant case, petitioner has lodged one complaint case bearing CA No. 2958 of 2023 against the informant and his daughter for duping and cheating on the pretext of false promise of marriage.

6. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

7. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody of the petitioner and clean antecedent of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

8. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with K.Nagar (Champanagar) P.S. Case No. 27 of 2024 , subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.

(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on



two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to
cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
