A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 326, 307, 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per F.I.R., petitioner no. 1 pressed the chest and mouth of informant, whereas, petitioner no. 2 cut the neck of the informant with knife. Doctor has found simple injury. Admittedly, there is land dispute between the parties, for which, a title suit, bearing Title Suit No. 53 of 2021, has already been filed in the court of learned Sub-Judge, Kahalgaon (Bhagalpur) from the petitioners' side.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.



5. Considering the nature of injury, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six weeks from today, let the above named petitioners be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned C.J.M., Bhagalpur in connection with Kahalgaon (Rasalpur) P.S. Case No. 1100 of 2023, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
