seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this writ application is being filed for issuance of writ nature of Mandamus for direction to remove the encroachment from the Khata No.202, Khesra No.1174 which is Gairmazrua Aam Sadak, which has been encroached by the respondents and further issue direction to respondents consider



the application of the petitioner for removing encroachment Aam Gairmazarua land which has not been removed till today in spite of the order passed in CWJC No. 14265/2019, in the compliance of the said very order respondent submitted show cause in MJC No.4610/2019 by stating that encroachment has been removed but still encroachment and further give other legal consequential benefit of the petitioner.”
