learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the

informant.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 376, 354(D), 341, 323, 504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, it is alleged that the petitioner forcibly made sexual relation with the victim, therefore, she fled away from there and she refused to talk to him, but the petitioner used to harass her through mobile phone.

4. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature.



He submits that the victim denied for her medical examination, it is apparent from para-33 of the case diary. He further submits that the victim in her statement under Section 164 of Cr.P.C. has supported the prosecution case. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State as well as learned counsel for the informant opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that victim is major and she denied for her medical examination, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Karpi P.S. Case No. 397 of 2023, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
