3 21-11-2024 The petitioner's contention was that the petitioner's private land was encroached upon by the Government.

2. Admittedly, the park built, which led to the allegation, was built as early as in 2015 and the writ petition was filed in the year 2019. The learned Single Judge found that there is an apparent civil dispute in respect to the land in question and the writ petition cannot be entertained.



3. We find absolutely no reason to interfere with the refusal to exercise discretion under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The appeal stands dismissed.
