A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Andhrathadi P.S. Case No. 172 of 2023 dated 10.12.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/s 307/34, 302 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons are alleged to have shot the informant's husband dead.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. There is no specific allegation against the petitioner. Similarly situated co-accused has already been granted bail by the co-ordinate bench of this court *vide* order dated 29.04.2024



passed in Cr. Misc. No. 29966 of 2024. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 15.01.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioner and the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Madhubani, in connection with Andhrathadi P.S. Case No. 172 of 2023 , with a condition/s:-

*(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to cancelled.*

7. The application stands allowed.
