2. The petitioner apprehends her arrest in the

case, this application for anticipatory bail is allowed.

Accordingly, let the petitioner, above-named, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M.-XIII, Gaya/concerned court below in connection with Atri P.S. Case No. 243 of 2022 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

8. This application for anticipatory bail is allowed.
