"1. That this writ application is preferred on behalf of the petitioner above named for issuance of appropriate writ/writs, order/orders, direction to concerned authorities to grant to J.P. Samman Pension to the petitioner by setting aside letter No.619 (Home Department) Special Branch, dated 21.07.2023 (Annexure-9) by which the petition of the petitioner has been rejected by the Secretary Counselor J.P. Samman Yojana



office Home Department Special Branch Govt. of Bihar Patna, denying the petitioner to grant the benefit of J.P. Samman Pension on Flimsy ground."
