ORAL ORDER

2 26-04-2024 1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief(s):-

“1(a) To direct the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Gaya to dispose of the Aaganbari Appeal Case No 50/2018, filed by the Petitioner, expeditiously within the specific time frame which is pending since 2018.

(b) To quash the order dated 31.08.2018 passed in Aaganbari Case No -30/2018, passed by learned District Programme officer, Gaya whereby and whereunder the Learned D.P.O., I.C.D.S., Gaya has not considered the case of



Petitioner that her house is physically situated in ward no-05 and being highest percentage in merit list, she is entitled for selection.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks a direction upon the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Gaya to dispose off the pending Anganwari Appeal Case No.15 of 2018, within a stipulated time frame.

3. The learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in case the aforesaid appeal is still pending, the same shall be disposed off, within a stipulated time frame, as is fixed by this Hon’ble Court.

4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I deem it fit and proper to direct the District Magistrate-cum-Collector, Gaya to dispose off the aforesaid appeal by passing a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six weeks of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

5. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
