ORAL ORDER

2 19-04-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in connection with Magadh Medical College P.S. Case No. 11 of 2024 instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341, 354, 307, 504, 379 and 386 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The allegation against the petitioners along with others is of assaulting the informant and his family members



due to which they sustained injury. It is further alleged that the accused persons have also snatched the articles from informant's family members.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the present case. Petitioners and informant are co-villagers and next door neighbour. There is general and omnibus allegation of assaulting against these petitioners and only with a view to save their own skin the informant has lodged the present case against them. There has been delay in lodging the FIR. There is a case and counter case between the parties and members of both parties have sustained injury as alleged in a separate occurrence. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. The petitioners are in custody since 31.01.2024 and have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, nature of injury as well as the period of custody undergone by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

7. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties
