2 03-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable u/s 341, 323, 324, 504, 506 & 34 IPC.

3. Allegation against the petitioners is that they along with other co-accused persons have assaulted the informant and his family members by means of various weapons.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that petitioners are quite innocent and have committed no offence. They have been falsely implicated in this case due to ulterior motive. There is an admitted land dispute between the parties



and there is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. The petitioners have enjoyed the benefit of section 41(a) of the Cr.P.C. The injuries have been found simple in nature. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.
6. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners, be released on bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/Successor Court in connection with Mohammadpur P.S. Case No.199 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
