been advised to make an inquiry with regard to the genuineness
of the employment of the private respondent no.7, namely Anju

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner, realizing the



fact that the Public Grievance Redressal Officer has got no authority under the law to get an inquiry conducted, with regard to the legitimacy of the employment of a Government servant, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the Director, Integrated Child Development Services, Bihar, Patna.
