ORAL ORDER

2 17-05-2024 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well
as the learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Wazirganj P.S. Case No. 576 of 2022, registered for the offences
punishable under Sections 30(a) and 45 of the Bihar Prohibition
and Excise Act 2016.

3. As per allegation, 310 liters of liquor was recovered
from the pick up van of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
earlier he was granted bail by this court, but at the time of grant
of bail, it was observed that if the petitioner is found involved in
any other case, his bail bond shall not be accepted. He has
further submitted that when the petitioner furnished bail bond, it



was not accepted as two criminal cases were detected against him.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the prayer for bail and submitted that the petitioner obtained the bail concealing his two criminal antecedents.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected. However, if so advised, he may renew his prayer for bail after six months.
