4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the present case. He further submits that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent as stated in paragraph 3 of the bail application.



5. However, learned APP for the State vehemently opposed the prayer for regular bail.

On perusal of the FIR, post mortem report and impugned order dated 20.01.2024, it appears that cause of death is due to suffocation and it also appears that the petitioner is named in the FIR and this case relates to for an offence punishable under Section 302 of the IPC, so considering the serious allegation levelled against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected.
