4 09-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the State.

2. Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 420, 406 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 138 of N I Act.

3 . By filing supplementary affidavit, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that dispute between the parties have already been compromised and in this regard a compromise petition has also been filed i. e, Annexure – p/1 to the bail petition .

4. Learned counsel for the State does not controvert the contention made on behalf of these petitioners.



5 . Considering the fact that compromise has already been made between the parties and circumstances of the case , in the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioners, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate , Saran in connection with Nayagaon P.S. Case No. 97 of 2023 , subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure .
