ORAL ORDER

3 27-06-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State and the S.H.O. of Rupaspur Police Station, who is present in Court.

2. The S.H.O. of Rupaspur Police Station has informed that pursuant to the order passed by the D.C.L.R. he has stopped the construction of the house of the petitioner though the petitioner is in possession of the land.



3. The S.H.O. cannot stop the construction of any house or any property unless there is injunction order of any Court/ Authority.

4. The S.H.O. of Rupaspur Police Station has submitted before this Court that he will not interfere in the possession and construction of the house of the petitioner in future unless there is an appropriate order of any Court/Authority.

5. With the aforesaid observations and directions, this criminal writ petition stands disposed of.
