2 13-02-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. That this is an application for
issuance of writ in the nature of
Mandamus or any other appropriate
writ or writs, order or direction
commanding the respondents to
include the name of petitioner in the
list of candidates published for final
interview for selection and
appointment on the Post of Lab
Technicians contained In Memo No-
873 dated 29.05.2020 (Annexure -5)
published by the Chairman, Staff
Selection Commission hereinafter*



referred to as the Commission by which legitimate claims of petitioner has been arbitrarily and malafidely not included by adopting selective policy and many juniors to petitioner has been included and petitioner working on the same post as Lab. Technician for about last 8 to 10 years has been not called for interview to fill up 1772 vacant posts of Lab. Technicians published against Advertisement No-905010115 dated 21.06.2015 (Annexure-1) and the petitioner has been arbitrarily put in disadvantageous position.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
