seeking the following relief:-

"1. That this writ application is being filed for issuance of writ nature of Mandamus for direction to remove the encroachment from the land bearing Mouza-Rajepur, P.S. +Circle-Dhaka, Khata No. 105, Khesra No.628, Area 7.031 decimal, which is concerned to the land of upgraded Middle
