ORAL ORDER

2 26-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

“1(i). For issuance of an appropriate Writ in the nature of CERTIORARI to quash the order dated 29.01.2024 (Annexure -13) passed in Anganbari Appeal No. 103/ 02021 filed by the Respondent No.7 against the order dated 24.12.2020 passed by the Respondent No. 4, whereby and whereunder he has remanded back to the matter to him, to make selection afresh within a month, in his presence, after quashing the order dated



24.12.2020 (Annexure-12) passed by the Respondent No.4.

(ii). For issuance of appropriate Writ in the nature of MANDAMUS to command the Respondent authority not to proceed against the Guideline / rule and regulation, issued by the Government of Bihar (Respondent No. 1).”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law including that of filing a suit before the learned Civil Court having competent jurisdiction. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
