ORAL ORDER

2 29-04-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned

A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Biraul P.S. Case No. 168 of 2021 dated 09.07.2021 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 341, 323, 379, 394 & 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, four unknown miscreants boarded on two different motorcycles are alleged to have stopped the informant and his uncle and snatched Rs. 45,000/- and also tried to snatch the new motorcycle from the informant and when the informant raised alarm, they fired from pistol on him.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to enmity. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. The name of the petitioner has sprung up



in the confessional statement of the co-accused, namely, Sitanshu Kumar. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has two criminal antecedent in which he is on bail as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 31.01.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Darbhanga in connection with Biraul P.S. Case No. 168 of 2021 with the condition/s:-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
