ORAL ORDER

2 26-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the present writ application is being filed on behalf of the sole petitioner for direction upon the respondents, particularly upon the respondent No. 2, to promote the petitioner on the post of Executive Engineer (Civil), with all the consequential benefits, with effect from 22nd of October 2023 i.e., the



date from which his immediate junior have been promoted, to the post of Executive Engineer (Civil) vide order contained in memo number 2762 dated 22nd of October 2023, issued under the signature of Joint Secretary (Management) Water Resources Department, Government of Bihar, Patna.”

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 2 i.e. the Additional Chief Secretary, Water Resources Department, Sinchai Bhawan, Old Secretariat, Patna, for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. It is needless to state that in case the petitioner approaches the respondent no. 2 i.e. the Additional Chief Secretary, Water Resources Department, Sinchai Bhawan, Old Secretariat, Patna, by filing appropriate representation, within a period of two weeks from today, the same shall be disposed off by a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of six



weeks, thereafter.

4. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
