Heard Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Singh, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Kameshwar Kumar, G.P.-17 representing all the respondents.

2. This writ petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondent authorities to consider the representation dated 21.02.2022 filed by the petitioner for taking appropriate decision with respect to his application for appointment on compassionate ground in accordance with policy decision.

3. The representation dated 21.02.2022 is stated to have been submitted to the respondent No.5 / The Block Development Officer, Manigachi Block, District Darbhanga, which has been annexed as Annexure 6 to the writ petition.
