ORAL ORDER

3 21-06-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P. on behalf of the State.

The instant application for regular bail has been

filed by the petitioner in connection with Jagdishpur
(Goradih) P.S. Case No. 312 of 2022 instituted for the

offence punishable under Sections 302, 120(B), 201 of the

Indian Penal Code.

Earlier the application for regular bail of the

petitioner was rejected by order dated 20.09.2023 passed in

Cr. Misc. No. 41296 of 2023 with an observation to learned

trial court to expedite the trial and conclude the same at the

earliest.



In pursuance to the direction of this Court, a report, dated 30.04.2024, with regard to present stage of trial has been received and the same is kept at flag 'P'. From its perusal it appears that the case may be disposed within a period of 6 months.

No fresh ground is made for reconsideration of the regular bail of the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer for grant of regular bail is rejected.

Accordingly, petition stands disposed off.

However, learned trial court is directed to conclude the trial within stipulated period ie. 6 months., failing which, the petitioner will be at liberty to renew his prayer of bail.
