2 03-07-2024 Heard Mr. Devendra Kumar, learned counsel for the

petitioner and Mr. Dilip Kumar No. 1, learned A.P.P. for the

State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Katra
(Jajuar O.P.) P.S. Case No. 263 of 2023 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 341 and 392/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, allegation against
the petitioner is that he snatched Rs.3,500/- and mobile from
the informant when he was going on tempo.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not
specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He submits that



the wife of the petitioner has filed a complaint case against the S.H.O., Inspector and other police for false implication of the petitioner. He further submits that no incriminating article has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail and submits that the petitioner is also involved in the present case.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of case, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is hereby rejected. However, if the petitioner surrenders before the learned Court below within six weeks from today and seek regular bail, the learned Court below would pass order on the same day in accordance with law without being prejudiced by this order.
