ORAL ORDER

2 26-04-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

*“1. For issuance of appropriate
Writ/Writs, direction/ directions or
orders/order especially in the
nature of Mandamus directing the*



respondents to grant promotion to the petitioner from the post of Inspector of Police to the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police from the date his juniors have been granted promotion on the post of Deputy Superintendent of Police vide Memo No.- 2/ C01- 20-01/2023 Home Department 1308/ dated 30/01/2024 issued by Deputy Secretary Home, Government of Bihar in terms of the eligibility acquired by the petitioner and further be pleased to direct the respondents for grant of consequential benefits after granting promotion from the date when juniors have been granted promotion."

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to approach the respondent no. 2 i.e. the Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Home (Police), Government of Bihar, Patna for redressal of his aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
3. It is needless to state that in case the



petitioner approaches the respondent no. 2 i.e. the Additional Chief Secretary, Department of Home (Police), Government of Bihar, Patna, by filing appropriate representation, within a period of one week from today, the same shall be disposed off by a reasoned and a speaking order, in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks, thereafter.

4. The writ petition stands disposed off on the aforesaid terms.
