A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 447, 379, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per F.I.R., this petitioner assaulted on the head of son of the informant by means of iron rod. Doctor has found the injury to be simple in nature. Petitioner has got clean antecedent.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

5. Considering the nature of injury and clean antecedent, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of six



weeks from today, let the above named petitioner be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. - II, Samastipur in connection with Tajpur P.S. Case No. 397 of 2022, corresponding to G.R. No. 2311 of 2022, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
