ORAL ORDER

2 08-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Pakrbarwan P.S. Case No. 623 of 2023 dated 24.12.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 394 of the Indian Penal Code later on Sections 395/412/212 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code was added.

3. As per the prosecution case, four unknown miscreants boarded on two motorcycles overtook the informant and stopped him and forcibly looted Rs. 23,000/-, mobile phone and his motorcycle on the point of pistol and fled away from the spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner



has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Chandan Kumar. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner has no concern with the alleged offence. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 05.01.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Nawada in connection with Pakribarawan P.S. Case No. 623 of 2023.

7. The application stands allowed.
