following relief(s):-

*“1. That this is an application for issuance of appropriate writ or writs direction or directions commanding the respondents particularly the respondent no.2 to implement the order dated 15.01.2024 passed by the District Public grievance redressal officer Darbhanga in Complaint Case No. 3812 Whereby and whereunder direction was issue to the respondent no. 3 to cancel the recognition of Madarsa Millatai Islamiya Pohaddi and to ensure the recovery of the aid amount and to lodged the FIR against the respondent no. 5 and its member who*



*have got recognition of the said Madarsa on the basis of the forged documents under the departmental rule.”*
