3 31-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in connection with Fenhara P.S. Case No. 110 of 2023 registered under Sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 324, 354(B), 379, 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, all the F.I.R. named accused persons including these petitioners assaulted informant and his



family members, on account of which, they sustained injuries.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case due to land dispute. Further submission is that there is case and counter case between the parties. The doctor has found the injuries simple in nature.

5. Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail-bonds of Rs. 10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Fenhara P.S. Case No. 110 of 2023, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
