“1. That the relief/reliefs that are being prayed for in this writ application is for grant of Swatantra Sainik Samman pension payable to the petitioner for the period 22.03.2012 to 6.3.2022 which is not paid to the petitioner after the death of her husband late Ram Singashan Mahto on 21.03.32012 to which she entitled to and also interest admissible on account thereof.”
