A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Garkha P.S. Case No. 410 of 2023, dated 13.07.2023, registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 159.18 litres of illicit English wine was recovered from the house of the petitioner.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The name of the petitioner



was disclosed by local Chowkidar.. The petitioner is in custody since 07.03.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Saran at Chhapra in connection with Garkha P.S. Case No. 410 of 2023.

7. The application stands allowed.
