ORAL ORDER

4 28-08-2024 The anticipatory bail application of petitioner No. 1



has already been withdrawn vide order dated 31.07.2024 .

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the pre-arrest bail application of petitioner No. 2.

3 . Permission is accorded.

4. Accordingly, prayer anticipatory bail of petitioner No. 2 is dismissed as withdrawn .

5 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner Nos. 3 and 4 and the State .

6. Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 147, 148 , 149, 341 , 323 , 307, 379, 448 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code .

7. As per prosecution case , petitioners Nos. 3 and 4 are alleged to have assaulted mother of informant. Doctor has found the injury simple in nature . Petitioners claim clean antecedent.

8 . Learned counsel for the State opposed the bail petition .

9. Considering the nature of injury , clean antecedent of these petitioners and other circumstances of the case , in the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from



today, let the petitioner Nos. 3 and 4, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate Sheikpura in connection with Sheikpura (Sirari) P.S. Case No. 90 of 2024 , subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure .
