ORAL ORDER

2 06-05-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Bangra P.S. Case No. 03 of 2024 dated 06.01.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 399 and 402 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25(1-B)a, 26 and 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons were gathered to commit crime. Upon seeing the police, the accused persons started fleeing away but three of them were apprehended by police. On search, one loaded country-made pistol, ATM card, Aadhar card and keypad were recovered from the possession of the petitioner.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is accused in four other criminal cases as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 07.01.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Samastipur in connection with Bangra P.S. Case No. 03 of 2024, with the condition :-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bonds of the petitioner are liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
