2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Sarai Ranjan P.S. Case No. 165/2023 vide S.T. No. 275/2024 dated 26.05.2023 registered for the offence punishable u/s 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, three unknown miscreants are alleged to have looted Rs. 2,32,540/- from *Dakshin Bihar Gramin Bank, Khalispur* on the point of pistol. Further, they also took away DVR of C.C.T.V. camera.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Nishant Kumar Sahni. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 01.08.2023.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Samastipur in connection with Sarai Ranjan P.S. Case No. 165/2023 vide S.T. No. 275/2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
