2 31-07-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners seeks bail in connection with a case regis-
tered for the offence punishable u/s 9, 39(1)(a)(b)(d), 40(2), 49,
4(B) of the Wildlife Protection Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, fifty persons were found near
bank of Jharna river and when the informant rushed there, all
the persons started to flee away from the spot and four of them
were identified, including the petitioners. 20 kg flesh of deer
was also recovered from the spot.

4. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that



petitioners are quite innocent and have not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. They have been falsely implicated in this case due to enmity. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioners. There is no specific overt act against the petitioners. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent and have been in judicial custody since 19.09.2023.

- 5. Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.
- 6. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and the period of custody, the above named petitioners are directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) **each** with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned court below where the case is pending/the Successor Court, in connection with Gaya Forest P.S. Case No.34 of 2016.
