4 19-09-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the respondents.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners' case is fully covered by the order passed by



this Court in CWJC No.3398 of 2020 dated 24.02.2024.

3. Considering the aforesaid fact, the petitioners are directed to file a detailed representation enclosing all the supporting documents and orders in their favour, before the respondent no.3 within a period of one month.

4. The respondent no.3 upon receipt of such representation, is well advised to dispose off the representation of the petitioners by passing a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law, in view of the decision of the Apex Court rendered in the case of **Durga Prasad Singh & Ors. vs. State of Bihar & Ors. (Civil Appeal No(s). 6178-6181/2015)**, within a period of ten weeks, thereafter.

5. If found entitled, the petitioners, shall be granted all consequential benefits.

6. With the aforesaid direction, this writ application is hereby disposed off.
