State.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered

for the offence punishable under sections 302, 120B and 34

of the Indian Penal Code .

3. As per the prosecution case, on November 18,

2023, at about 11.30 a.m., while the informant was at his

house at Village *Hopnathpur*, he received information that his

son *Manish Kumar*, aged about 22 years, had been killed by

co-accused *Purushottam. Kumar* along with his two to three

associates in village *Kharka* . Informant suspects that this



petitioner, including other co-accused persons, were also involved in committing the murder of his son .

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been made accused in this case only on suspicion. It is the specific case of the informant that there was money dispute between the co-accused *Purushottam Kumar* and deceased due to which co-accused *Purushottam Kumar* committed murder of the deceased. Informant is not the eye witness of the alleged occurrence . Except suspicion, there is no direct or indirect material available on the record to show the complicity of the petitioner in the present case. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.

5. Learned counsel for the State opposes the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts, clean antecedent of the petitioner and other circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Id. CJM, Sitamarhi in connection with Panaura PS case No. 258 of 2023 subject to the conditions laid down under section



438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure .
