2 21-10-2024 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned AC to GP-18.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the instant writ application has been filed seeking a writ of mandamus for a direction upon the respondents to modify the compensation as has been assessed by the District Land Acquisition Officer, Bhojpur which was not as per the market value of the land as such petitioner has suffered heavy monetary loss.

3. Learned AC to GP-18, at the outset, submits that in the nature of prayer made in the writ application, the writ application is not maintainable as petitioners have remedy of



approaching the competent authority for redressal of their grievances on which learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the writ application with liberty to move before the competent authority for redressal of their grievances.

4. Permission is accorded.

5. Accordingly, the writ application is dismissed as withdrawn.
