ORAL ORDER

2 29-04-2024 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek bail in Jaynagar P.S. Case No. 72 of 2024, instituted for the offences punishable under Sections 272, 273, 414, 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that, 828 liters liquor was recovered from a car and from a nearby place out of which 558 liters liquor was recovered from the car of the petitioners. The petitioners were apprehended on spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. No incriminating material have been recovered



from the conscious possession of the petitioners. The petitioners have got no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. It is further submitted that petitioner no. 1 is driver and petitioner no. 2 is co-driver of the seized vehicle and both of them have no knowledge regarding the goods loaded in the vehicle. The petitioners are in custody since 02.03.2024. Petitioner No. 1 has got one criminal antecedent in which the petitioner is on bail and Petitioner No. 2 has got no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 100 of Cr.P.C.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and the period of custody undergone by the petitioners, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

7. Let the petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Jaynagar P.S. Case No. 72 of 2024.
