seeking the following relief:-

“1. That the instant writ application is being filed on behalf of the petitioners herein, for issuance of appropriate writ or writs, direction or directions, order or orders, commanding the respondents to act in accordance with provision of the



Act and Rules (Bihar Irrigation Act and Rules, 1997) and grant reliefs for which the petitioners, who are owners, entitled for.”
