ORAL ORDER

3 10-07-2024 The present writ petition has been filed
seeking the following relief:-

“1. That this application is being filed against highly illegal and wrongful action on the part of the respondents by which despite repeated representation for removal of encroachment from the public land situated in Mauza- Sadokhar, Thana No. 500, Khata No. 351, Plot No. 842, area-97 decimal no action has been taken till date due to which the public land is



being encroached by encroachers and the people are being made to suffer.”

2. After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to approach the Circle Officer, Chenari, Rohtas for redressal of their aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

3. Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed off.
