“1. That this petition is being filed in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the order dated 28.06.2022 issued vide memo no. 17(MU) whereby and whereunder the District Programme Officer, ICDS, Aurangabad has amended/reviewed his own order by reversing own order dated 10.07.2020 issued vide memo no.



1071 going contrary to rule that the Administrative Officer is not empowered to amend/alter his own order."

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances.
